

### TIPS

- Be specific about what you would like to address e.g. marketplace harassment, sexual harassment in schools, girl child education etc.
- Ask for help; collaborate with your classmates, teachers, parents or others.
- Do what inspires you. Passion is what keeps you going so pick a cause that is important to you and a campaign that interests you.
- Do your research, how has the issue been addressed in the past? how will you address it moving forward, how will your campaign help?
- Fail forward! You might start an idea that doesn't work at first, learn from it and keep going!


